We are delighted to have Samuel Barber, MD present "Understanding BAHA: An Overview of Bone Conduction Hearing Devices." Dr. Barber will provide a brief history of bone conduction technologies, review current commercially available devices, provide a summary of patients who may benefit from a BAHA, and comparisons

of BAHA to both traditional hearing amplification devices and cochlear implants.

Barber is an otolaryngologist and a neurologist in the Department of ENT and Skull Base Surgery at Barrow Neurological Institute. Dr. Barber's expertise lies in the medical and surgical management of all types of hearing and vestibular disorders. He specializes in the surgical implantation of advanced hearing technologies, including cochlear implants, auditory brainstem implants and bone-anchored hearing devices.

Dr. Barber earned his Medical Degree with Research Honors from Tufts University School of Medicine in Boston, Massachusetts. He completed his residency in otolaryngology-head and neck surgery at the University of Arizona College of Medicine in Tucson.
